
Oral History Agreement of Benjamin R. Civiletti

1. In consideration of the recording and preservation of my oral history memoir by the Historical Society of the District of Columbia Circuit, Washington, D.C., and its employees and agents (hereinafter "the Society"), I, Benjamin R. Civiletti, wish to retain all of my rights, title and interest in the tape recordings, transcripts, and computer diskette of the interviews of me, as described in Schedule A hereto, including literary rights and copyrights. All copies of the tapes, transcripts and diskette are subject to the same restrictions.

2. Notwithstanding the restrictions stated in paragraph 1 hereof, I hereby grant, convey and license access to and use of the tapes, transcripts, and diskette by the Society and its members and staff, provided however that neither the Society nor its members and staff shall publish the tapes, transcripts, or diskette, or any part thereof, including brief quotations, during my lifetime without my express written permission.


3. Effective at my death or 15 years from the date of this Agreement, whichever first occurs, I do hereby grant and convey to the Society and its successors and assigns all of my rights, title and interest in the tape recordings, transcripts, and computer diskette of the interviews of me, as described in Schedule A hereto, including literary rights and copyrights.

4. Any restrictions on use of said tapes, transcripts, and diskette stated in paragraph 1 or 2 hereof shall be removed at my death or 15 years from the date of this Agreement, whichever first occurs, and thereafter the Society may duplicate, edit, publish, or permit the use of said tapes, transcripts, and diskette in any manner that the Society considers appropriate (including publication on the internet), and I waive any claims I may have or acquire to any royalties from such use.


