About the Artist

BRADLEY STEVENS

Bradley Stevens has been painting portraits professionally for over 38 years. Raised in Westport, Connecticut, Mr. Stevens came to Washington, D.C. to attend George Washington University, where he earned both a Bachelor of Fine Arts and a Masters of Fine Arts.

In addition to his formal art studies, Mr. Stevens spent five years copying several hundred Old Masters paintings at the National Gallery of Art. He soon garnered a reputation for this work, and he has been commissioned to reproduce historic portraits for institutions such as the Smithsonian, the U.S. State Department, the U.S. House of Representatives, Mount Vernon, and Monticello.

Mr. Stevens' portrait of civil rights leader Vernon Jordan hangs in the permanent collection of the National Portrait Gallery. Other notable portraits include Judge Reggie B. Walton, Judge Ellen Segal Huvelle, Senator Mark Warner, Senator John D. Rockefeller IV, and former Secretary of the Interior Sally Jewell. Mr. Stevens is currently working on a portrait of retiring George Washington University President Steven Knapp.

About the Vocalist

D.C. Washington is a member of the nationally known Cathedral Choral Society in Washington, D.C. He also is a frequent singer of the national anthem for the Washington Football Team, the Washington Nationals, and D.C. United. Mr. Washington has been featured at many conferences around the country and overseas, including Moody Bible Institute Founder's Week and Pastors' Conference. Most recently Mr. Washington was invited to sing the National Anthem for the inauguration of the Honorable Asa Hutchinson as the Governor of Arkansas.

Mr. Washington is a graduate of the University of Central Arkansas and Mississippi College. He served for 22 years in the United States Army and is a member of the Immanuel Bible Church, its choir, and several ensembles.
