

Oral History Agreement of George W. Jones, Jr.



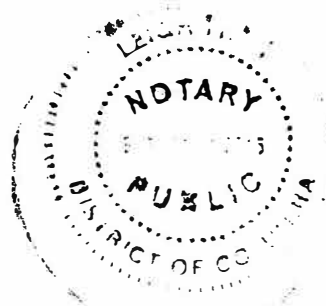


