1. 3. I agree that I will make no use of the interviews or the information contained therein until the interviews are concluded and the transcripts thereof are edited, or until I receive permission from the Society.



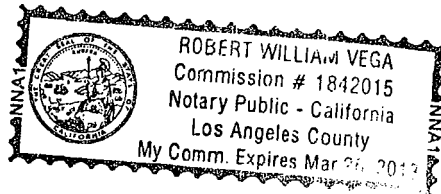


