3. I agree that I will make no use of the oral history or the information contained therein without permission from the Society.



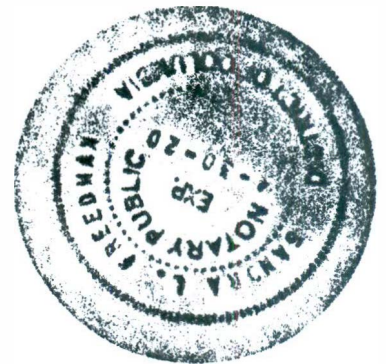
