





3. I agree that I will make no use of the oral history or the information contained therein until it is concluded and edited, or until I receive permission from the Society.



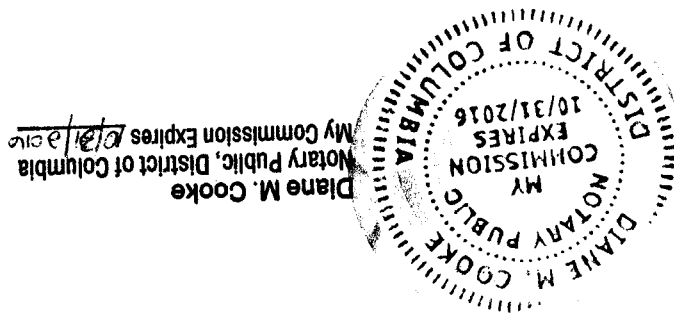


