Agreement

1. In consideration of the recording and preservation of the oral history memoir, prepared by Michael P. Socarras and George E. MacKinnon, by the Historical Society of the District of Columbia Circuit, Washington, D.C., its employees and agents (hereinafter "the Society") I, Elizabeth D. MacKinnon, personal representative, heir and beneficiary of the Estate of George E. MacKinnon, do hereby grant and convey to the Society, its successors and assigns, the ownership of the tape recordings and transcripts of interviews resulting from interviews of George E. MacKinnon on February 18, 1994. I also grant and convey to the Society all right, title, and interest I or he might have in such tapes, transcripts and their content, including literary rights and copyrights. All copies of the tapes and transcripts are subject to the same restrictions.

2. I have not previously conveyed, assigned, encumbered or impaired my rights and interest in the tapes, transcripts and their content referred to above.

3. It is agreed that access to the aforementioned tape recordings and transcripts shall be in accordance with the direction and control of the Society and subject to terms to be set by the Society. I authorize the Society, subject to the above and to any exceptions contained herein, to duplicate, edit, publish, or permit the use of said tape recordings and transcripts in any manner that the Society considers appropriate, and I waive my claim to any royalties from such use.
