I authorize the Society to duplicate, edit, publish, including publication on the internet, and permit the use of said tape recordings, digital recordings, transcripts, computer diskettes and DVDs in any manner that the Society considers appropriate, and I waive any claims I may have or acquire to any royalties from such use.
