About the Artist

BRADLEY STEVENS

Bradley Stevens has been painting portraits professionally for over 37 years. Raised in Westport, CT, Bradley Stevens came to Washington, DC, to attend George Washington University, where he earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts and Masters of Fine Arts.

In addition to his formal art studies, Stevens spent five years copying several hundred Old Master paintings at the National Gallery of Art. He soon garnered a reputation for this work, and has been commissioned to reproduce historic portraits by institutions such as the Smithsonian, U.S. State Department, U.S. House of Representatives, Mount Vernon, and Monticello.

Soon after graduation, Stevens was invited to teach drawing and portrait painting as an adjunct professor at his alma mater and Georgetown University. He taught at both institutions for 18 years until deciding in 2000 to focus solely on his painting.

Stevens' portrait of civil rights leader Vernon Jordan hangs in the permanent collection of the Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery. Other notable portraits include Senator Mark Warner, Senator John D. Rockefeller IV, Albert Small, B.F. Saul, Congressman Buck McKeon, and David Trone. Stevens is currently working on portraits of Judge Reggie Walton and Secretary of the Interior Sally Jewell.

His portraits are found in the collections of numerous government institutions, universities, corporations, courts, and hospitals, including NIH, General Dynamics, Lazard Frères, University of Chicago, and Johns Hopkins Hospital.

Stevens and his artist wife live and work in their home in the Virginia countryside near Washington, DC.
