

## **Elizabeth A. Cavanagh Biographical Sketch**

Elizabeth A. Cavanagh is the Associate Director of the SJD Program at the Washington College of Law at American University. Professor Cavanagh has taught legal research and writing as well as appellate advocacy, and previously worked at Jenner & Block's D.C. office as an appellate and trial court litigator. She attended Dartmouth College and Yale Law School. Following graduation, she clerked for the Honorable Louis F. Oberdorfer of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia and for Justice John Paul Stevens of the U.S. Supreme Court. Professor Cavanagh serves on the board of a nonprofit organization devoted to improving legal representation for domestic violence survivors, and also helps screen cases for the Mid-Atlantic Innocence Project. She is admitted to practice law in D.C. and Maryland.
